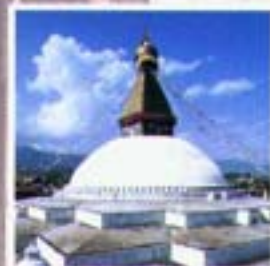
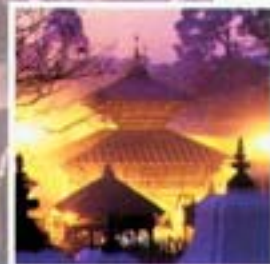

Bhaktapur

Bhaktapur, also known as Bhadgoan is undoubtedly one of the most amazing living museums of the world.

Dating back to 889AD this city, which is built in the shape of a conch still exists in the medieval era. Here time has stood still. The exquisite art and architecture prevailing in the numerous palaces, temples, monuments and the tradition of ancient weaving, pottery and wood carving and the age old festivals and dances are still practiced with the same fervor of the days gone by.



The Highlights of Bhaktapur



The Bhaktapur Durbar Square

Constructed during the 15th century, the impressive 55 Windows Palace and the Golden Gate are known to be some of the most exquisite works of art at the Durbar Square.



Taumadhi Square

This square is famous for the Nyatapole Temple. This five-storied temple is one of the finest examples of Nepalese Pagoda style architecture and craftsmanship.



Dattatraya Square

Renown for the intricate wood carving of the Peacock Window at the Pujarimath this square is equally popular.

Besides, the Bhairab Temple, Thangka Art Gallery and a number of other temples, courtyards, monuments and monasteries all exemplify the exquisite Nepalese art and architecture.



Pashupatinath

Pashupatinath is the most famous Hindu temple in Nepal. This 600-year-old temple is built in Pagoda Style and has gilded roof and intricately carved silver doors.
